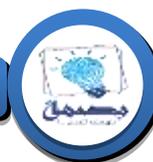
My Wardrobe

This long-sleeved jumper with wide sleeves is one of my favourites. It's incredibly comfortable and it matches perfectly with these loose-fitting trousers. I always choose clothes made from natural fabrics like cotton and wool because they're very soft and easy to look after. I prefer clothes in plain colours to patterns like polka dots or paisley. I have short dark-brown hair and a beard and I usually dress casually. I think my clothes match my appearance. My favourite piece of clothing is my black leather jacket and I choose my other clothes to go with that. For my daily college routine, I often wear dark-blue jeans with a classic belt.
